

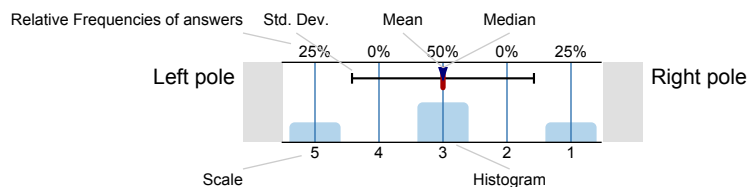

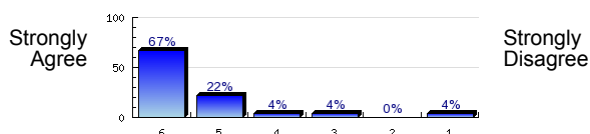

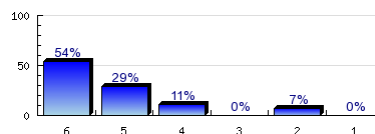

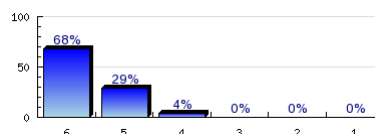

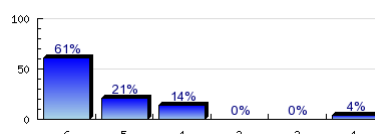

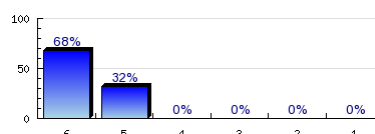

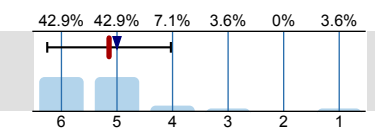

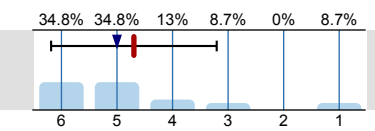

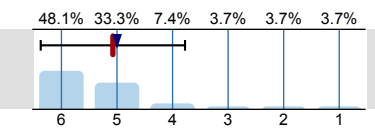

-Instructor needs to start teaching and stop talking about Home Depot and other things besides accounting. Instructor should allow students the opportunity to practice work in class with demonstration examples. Power point presentation is not helpful at learning the topic.

This reminds me of a University course. The teacher assigns us material so we learn on our own, and each class makes himself a resource to fill in the gaps. I think he would work very well for an online class. I heard a girl emailed him to change his teaching style. That's a silly idea, and he should ignore it. Put emphasis on learning and teaching yourself the material, so slower people like her, can understand how to efficiently learn and succeed in not only this class, but on a college level.

The discussions in class are interesting but the instructor simplifies the material too much when he explains it. The homework, quizzes, and tests are more difficult than the instructor explains them to be. He is a nice, approachable person, but needs to be more in-depth with his explanations.

I love how quickly he grades exams. I dislike how classroom teaching is conceptually based, homework is given in multiple-choice format and the exam was given as a practical, hands-on assignment.

Sometimes it feels like I get pity points on my tests because there isn't any explanation of where I'm gaining or losing points on large and involved questions. I need to know that I am earning the points that I receive to feel confident about my understanding of the material.

The quizzes do not relate to the homework or tests (problem-solving wise). The questions given on the on-line quizzes are not always covered in lecture. The homework is relevant to the in class tested material.
